

# Mineral Assessment Tool




Track mining projects and guide community decisions

## Why It Matters

- Determine which projects are **more likely** to turn into a mine and **generate impacts**—positive or negative
- Decide where should the community **prioritize their time and resources** to respond effectively—e.g., impact assessment, engagement, negotiation

## Assessment Methodology

- Easy to use—based on terms commonly used by industry
- Multiple indicators—to help compare and increase robustness
- Public info only—all data online
- No expertise needed—basic training and research skills
- Targeted online search—find key terms in proponent docs
- A living tool—we welcome feedback to refine/improve/adapt the tool to meet Nations' priorities

Very few projects turn into mines

Broad Statistics:

- 1 in 100,000 mineral tenures
- 1 in 10,000 exploration projects
- 1 in 1,000 exploration drill projects
- 1 in 10 defined deposits

### In-Depth MAT

Resource Assessment

**Pillar 2:**  
Technical Studies Completed

**Pillar 3:**  
Project Financials

**Pillar 4:**  
Corporate Profile & Financials

**Pillar 5:**  
Indigenous Relations & Consent

### Quick MAT:

Focus on first two pillars to spot priority projects fast when time and capacity are tight.

## MAT Service Options

### Quick MAT—Per Project

One project, one assessment, one results table. Starting at **\$800** (Pillars 1 & 2) or **\$1,600** (all 5 Pillars).

### In-Depth MAT—Per Territory

Compare several projects, tailor the tool to your needs, and receive a full report with visuals and a workshop discussion. Starting at **\$25,000** for 10+ projects, up to **\$95,000** for 50+ projects.

### MAT Training—Up to 5 Trainees

Learn to use the MAT, from a short overview to full hands-on training covering all 5 Pillars. Starting at **\$3,500** (Pillars 1 & 2), up to **\$10,500** (all 5 Pillars and hands-on practice).
